



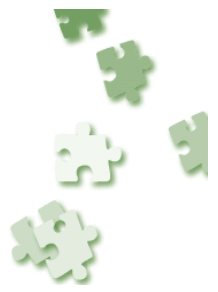

Autism NZ Canterbury Branch October Holidays – Aspergers Programme Living Springs Trip

Dates: Tuesday 18th October 2011 – Thursday 20th October 2011 (times tbc)

Following conversations on previous Holiday Programmes with some of the Aspergers Group, we have taken the decision during the October School Holidays to run a 3 day camp at Living Springs.

Whilst we would like to open this up to everyone, we are limited on the numbers we are able to take, and as such we have taken the decision to start with to open it up to the Aspergers Group, for those between the ages of 12 and 21.

Should we find that we do not have enough we will then open it up further.



Costs: 4 days Carer Support or \$350 (this covers the cost of the accommodation, transport, activities, all meals and staffing for the 3 days)- **Please note this will need to be claimed before the holidays as we need to pay upon arrival, so please allocate us 4 days to claim (if in doubt please contact the office)**

Activities: Not limited to, but likely to include – Bush Walks, Low Ropes, Archery, Orienteering, Swimming, Mini-golf, Monorail, Trampolines, Tennis Courts etc....

Whilst we understand in some situations some people are unable to take part in certain activities, we would like to encourage all participants on the trip to have a go at as many of the activities we do as possible.

As part of the stay, the group will be required to help set tables for meals, wash dishes and clean areas used at the end of our stay (accommodation, dining, communal areas).

Application: This opportunity will be on a first come first served basis until we reach the limit of children we can take on the camp. As with our usual Aspergers Programme we will staff the camp on a 3:1/4:1 basis, as well as ensuring we have both male and female members of staff available.

Due to the need to gather certain information in relation to the camp, a separate application form will need to be completed in full.

We will also try to arrange an evening get together before the camp to allow everyone to get together, and for us to go through any queries anyone may have.
